6. Brief details of the support services in the University from the following:-

**Central Library** : The Central Library initially started in a rented accommodation in the city, was shifted to its permanent building at Tanhril Campus in the month of December, 2007. However, only 25% of the building is ready for occupation and construction work for the rest is still in progress. The Library has a collection of more than 60,000 books and 6,000 nos. of bound volumes of Journals. The Library has been providing lending and reprographic services, orientation programme for academic Deptts. and internet service to students and teachers. It is presently manned by the following:-

The Central Library subscribes to 270 journals, 31 popular magazines and 25 dailies with a membership of 1000 approximately.

**Computer Centre** : The Computer Centre is headed by a System Administrator, supported by a Technical Assistant and a Peon. It provides computing facilities to students, teaching and Non-teaching staff of the University as well as imparting technical knowledge to students and staff alike. There are at present, as many as 25 high end Computers available for the users. Broadband Internet connection is provided through VSAT. Initiatives had been taken towards bandwidth upgrade. It is expected that leased-line Internet connection with 2 Mbps bandwidth will be commissioned within August 2008.

Computer training programme for non-teaching staff of the University has been chalked out and planned for start up during academic vacations. The trainings will be for basic and intermediate levels. The main objective of these trainings will be in preparing the employees for E-governance.

The Computer Centre is a Data Centre for Campus Networking, which has covered all existing Academic and Administrative buildings. The Campus Network runs on a robust optical fibre backbone with a number of IP Phones. The Internet connection is shared over the campus LAN. As many as six high-configuration Windows and Linux servers are running presently.

The Centre has developed Intranet applications such as, Intranet Mail, Intranet Website, etc. LAN messenger software was installed in all computers and it is being extensively utilized by all employees for quick communications such as sharing of files, data and voice chat, etc.

The Centre has licensed copies of software such as Oracle 10g, SPSS 15.0, e-Trust antivirus/security packages along with a number of Microsoft products which are covered under Campus Licensing Agreement.

**Health Centre** : Preventive and curative medical facilities are undertaken by the University's Health Centre. The Centre is further equipped with basic pathological facilities inclusive of pharmaceutical dispensing. The Health Centre is manned by the following:-

**Sports Facilities** : MZU is equipped with a Sports Department headed by an Assistant Director of Sports with peripheral staffs. The department is governed by a Sports Board under the chairmanship of the Registrar, MZU. This department has regularly been taking initiative in hosting different sports programmes within the state. The department also takes pride in imparting physical and professional education to students of the University and colleges of the state by utilizing the expertise of professional coaches. The Sports department has further fanned out their activities through participation in inter-state tournaments etc in the country.

**Workshop** : Construction of University Workshop for Engineering Students is being processed.

**Hostels** : The University is currently running a temporary Post Graduate (Men's) Hostel with intake capacity of 30 students only in the campus premises. Accordingly, constructions of four units of 100 seater capacity hostels are in progress.

**Guest House** : A Guest house facilities of 24 units is presently under construction and is due for completion by the year end.

**Canteen** : At present, the university is outsourcing canteen services to reputed restaurateurs of the state and has installed four such units for easy access of University employees and students. Over and above this, there is an on-going plan to provide a higher standard of in-house cafeterias within the university campus.

**Welfare Schemes** : The University has allowed formation of various Welfare Associations viz. Mizoram University Teachers Association, Mizoram University Non-teaching Staff Association, Group ‘A’ Welfare Committee.

**Grievance Redressal Cell** : The University has introduced a Grievance Redressal mechanism in the University. The Grievance Redressal Cell is headed by a Director cum Professor of the University, namely, Prof. T.C. Nunga, Dept of Economics. As a means to render effective and efficient disposal of grievances, the Vice Chancellor, MZU, in consultation with the Executive Council, has been empowered as the Appellate Authority.

**Any other** : In order to comply with directions of Govt. of India and Statutory requirements, the following Cells/Committees have been set-up to ensure smooth running of the University :

- 1) Vigilance Cell: The orders and instructions regarding Vigilance matters are monitored and implemented through the University Vigilance Cell. The cell is headed by the Registrar, MZU who has been designated as Vigilance Officer.
  - 2) Equal Opportunity Cell: The University has set up Equal Opportunity Cell which is headed by the Registrar, MZU as Chief Liaison Officer and Deputy Registrar, MZU as Liaison Officer for SC/ST/OBC/PWD.
  - 3) Anti-Ragging Committee: The University has set up Anti-Ragging Committee headed by Dean, Students’ Welfare with students’ representative as member besides others. Incidentally, it is mentioned that the University has no record of ragging so far.
  - 4) Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment at Workplace etc: This committee is being headed by Prof. (Mrs.) Margaret Ch. Zama, HOD, Dept of English, MZU with Ms. Lalbiakdiki Hnamte, Dept of English, MZU as Member Secretary and Ms. Marli Vankung, Judicial Officer, District Council Court, Aizawl and Dr. Rakesh Mohan, Dept of Forestry, MZU as its members.
